Easter Candle Carving

For ages 10+ (with adult)

You will need: white wax candles, sharp pencil, small sharp knife, acrylic pain and rags

Your children warm a candle by rubbing it between their hands. Next they carefully scratch a pattern onto the candle with the pencil and, using the knife, they carve out a pattern.

When that is finished, they polish the candle with a soft rag and then rub the candle surface with some acrylic paint, making sure the paint goes into the carved surface.

When the paint is dry they polish it again with a soft cloth.

Light them for Easter lunch or they make a wonderful gift for someone special.

Leave a basket at the door or in the bedroom and then make up clues which will test the youth's imagination and skills.

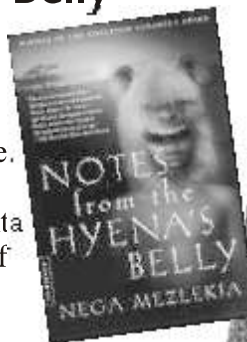


BOOKS OF THE WEEK

You solve the puzzle with reasoning and logic.

Solving time is typically from 10 to 30 minutes, depending on your skill and experience.

kakuro

Kakuro is a puzzle game that's a cross between both traditional crosswords and Sudoku.

Just like Sudoku you must fit the digits 1 to 9 into a grid of squares so that no digit is repeated within a defined area. And just like a crossword there's a grid of filled blocks and clues to solve.

In Kakuro, there are **across** and **down** clues, just like in a crossword, but they give the **sum** of the digits in the relevant areas - which is why the puzzles are also called Cross Sums. The clues are written within the grid, to the left or the top of the area they apply to.
