The Year 2009 will mark the 400th Anniversary of the Settling of the Island, as well as the 50th Anniversary of the Theatre Boycott. These two key milestones in the history of Bermuda are different, in a variety of ways. However they share a commonality in that they represent periods when our fore-bearers faced very significant challenges and transformed them into opportunities. Those involved in these two chapters of our history, were confronted with situations that could have been considered insurmountable, at the time. Those who effected the transformation of these two sets of circumstances, were able to do this by exercising a uniquely Human capacity, that is the power of Imagination. Those of us who have been handed the gift of Bermuda today are also facing

challenges. One could argue that current circumstances don't rival those which were faced by those who came before us. In an effort to honour the stewardship for which we are all charged, in this new millennium, a group of residents have begun the initiative, **'Imagine Bermuda 2009'**. To this end, we have begun a series of dialogues in the parishes, using a technique called Appreciative Inquiry, with a view to including a conversation involving the all sectors of our diverse community.
